- Applicants must be seeking **full time** status as a licensed real estate agent.
- Applicants must apply through a Licensed Real Estate Broker to qualify.
- Only one applicant per real estate office may apply.

Make a copy for your files. You will complete the essay as described on page 2 and answer all of the questions on the application. Include your essay with your application.

Applications must be received or postmarked by April 1, 2012

Applications postmarked after that date will not be considered.

Notifications of decisions will be emailed to all applicants by April 10, 2012.
